## **Fall Agility Cup 2019**

**Entries for the Cup will close on November 1, 2019**

This will be an unsanctioned agility competition for bragging rights, bling, and the big bucks only! There are no qualifying scores or titles awarded. Competition will consist of Speedstakes and The Fall Cup.

Nancy Kemna will design and judge the Speedstakes rounds. Nancy will present a set of courses for dogs and handlers looking for something fast and fun similar in style to UKI Speedstakes or USDAA Steeplechase (no A-Frame). Beginner Speedstakes is jumps and tunnels only. Master Speedstakes is jumps, tunnels, and 12 weave poles. You may enter both rounds!

The Fall Cup Jumping and Agility will be designed by Jari Suomalainen of Riihimäki, Finland judged by Jim Massey (Large) and Dave Slieger (Small). The Fall Cup will run Jumping first, followed by Agility.

The Fall Cup Final agility round will be designed by Jari Suomalainen, judged by Jim Massey and Dave Slieger.

Courses will be reviewed for safety by Nancy Gyes.

Scoring will be time plus faults. Judging will be per AKC ring rules except as modified herein and scored as follows: Refusals + 5 seconds; Faults +5 seconds (bar or missed contact); Wrong Course +20 seconds if corrected, Elimination if not corrected. European style training in the ring is allowed (*see below*).

In addition to bragging rights, first through third place for each height for the speedstakes rounds and preliminary fall cup rounds receive a neck ribbon placement medal.

**The Fall Cup Final** winners will receive a trophy, 10% of the entry fees for their jump height, and a toy; the runner-up will receive 5% of the entry fees for their jump height, and a toy; third place will receive a toy.

Agility and Jumping are preliminary rounds, the Final is a true final to test your mettle under pressure!

ALL dogs run the final, not all dogs compete in the final. Mix n' Match entries are not scored for awards. Dogs with eliminations in both rounds are not scored for awards. Dogs with an elimination in one round **and** a podium placement in the other round compete in the final, seeded ahead in the run order from dogs with scores in both runs. All dogs with scores in both jumping and agility compete in the final in reverse seed order. The Fall Cup will be awarded to the winner of the final round.

Jump heights offered will be 4"/8" (scored together), 12", 16", 20" and 24". You may pick the best height for your dog. Dogs will not be measured.

Dogs must be at least 15 months of age. Bitches in Season (BIS) will be accommodated; handlers need to bring a mat for the start line.

"European Style" (aka "Fix and Continue") training in the ring means that a team may correct a sequence, or a repeat a contact and provide verbal praise and play as reward and then go on with the course. Once a team has elected to train a sequence or obstacle the run will be scored as an elimination. Verbal praise alone will not be cause for elimination; it will be at the judge's discretion if the team has chosen to end their competitive run to train. Teams are expected to be respectful in their choices about training in the ring, and **NO harsh correction will be tolerated**.

The competition ring is not separated from the crating area by a physical barrier. Dogs should be on leash when not working in the ring.

The only practice jump / warm up area available will be outside, on grass.

The Cup is limited to the first 240 runs. The Cup will begin at 9:30 a.m. running small to tall and is expected to finish by 4:00 p.m. If time allows, we will offer \$5 mulligans on the Agility Finals course after the Cup once awards have been presented.

### **Directions**

From the North: Take I-5 southbound to Exit 182 I 405 S towards Renton. After approximately 20 miles take exit 2A to merge onto Hwy 167 S towards Kent/Auburn. In approximately 20 miles take the WA-410 E exit towards Sumner/Yakima. In approximately 2 miles take the 166 Ave E exit. Turn left onto 166 Ave E/ Sumner Tapps Hwy and then turn left onto 60<sup>th</sup> St E. Sumner Veterinary Hospital and It's a Dog's World Training is on the left.

From the South: Take I-5 North to Exit 127, Puyallup / WA-512 E. In approximately 12 miles merge onto Hwy 167 N towards WA-410 E. Take the WA-410 E exit towards Sumner/Yakima. In approximately 2 miles take the 166 Ave E exit. Turn left onto 166 Ave E/ Sumner Tapps Hwy and then turn left onto 60<sup>th</sup> St E. Sumner Veterinary Hospital and It's a Dog's World Training is on the left.

**Waiver - AGREEMENT:** This document records the agreement of the undersigned owner of any dog (a) being trained at or otherwise utilizing the facilities of It's a Dog's World / Sumer Vet Hospital, (b) participating in any event in which MayaLu Training and It's a Dog's World / Sumer Vet Hospital are acting, at its facility or other premises, as a sponsor, facilitator or participant of and at a dog training or competition event, seminar, exhibition, show or fundraiser (together "Activity"), (c) that within the scope hereof It's a Dog's World / Sumer Vet Hospital includes its owners and independent contractors while performing their respective MayaLu Training and It's a Dog's World / Sumer Vet Hospital duties and actions, and (d) as such owner I hereby affirm:
